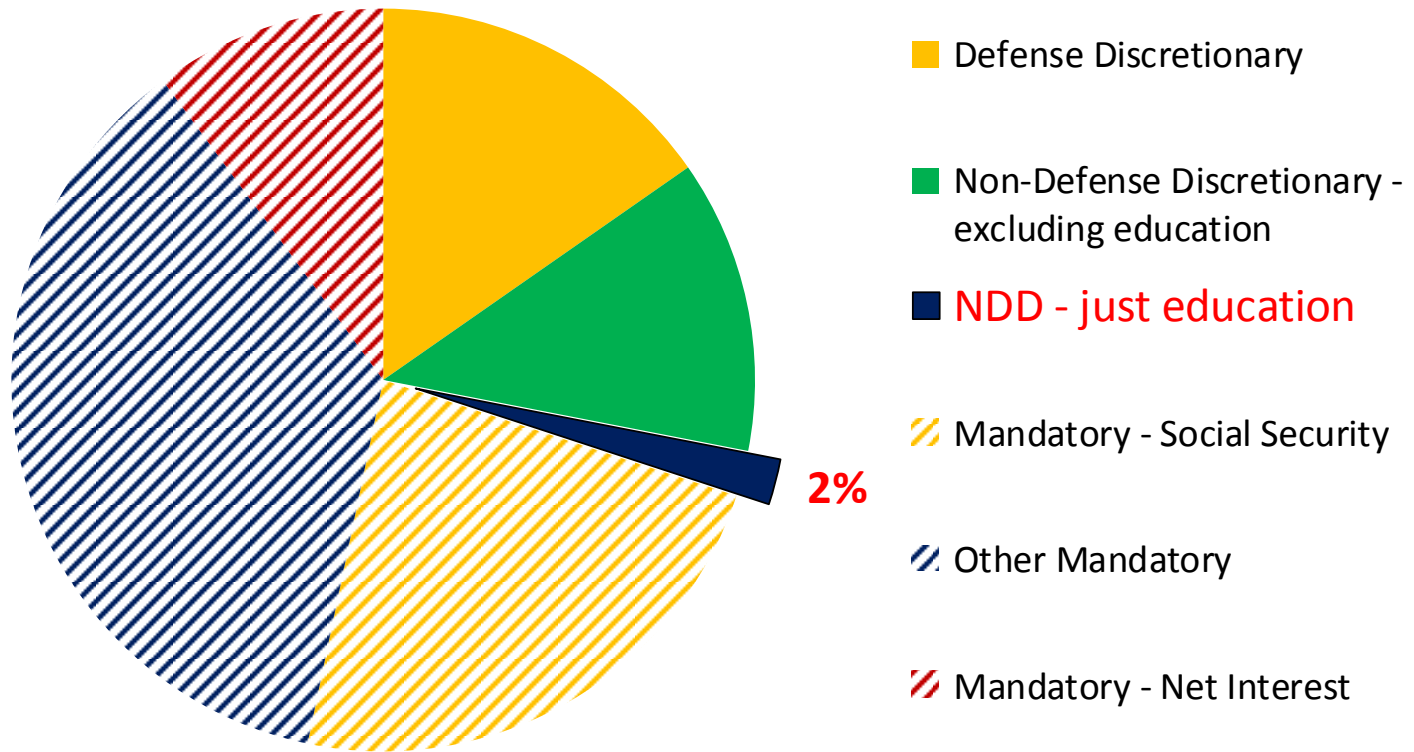


Basic Budget Process Deadlines

- President's Budget Request 1st Monday in February
- Congressional Budget Resolution by April 15
- House and Senate Appropriations Committees can start work May 15
- 12 subcommittees write and pass bills in the summer
 - Labor-HHS-Education
- Conference agreements between 12 House and Senate versions of spending bills by September 30
- October 1, first day of federal fiscal year

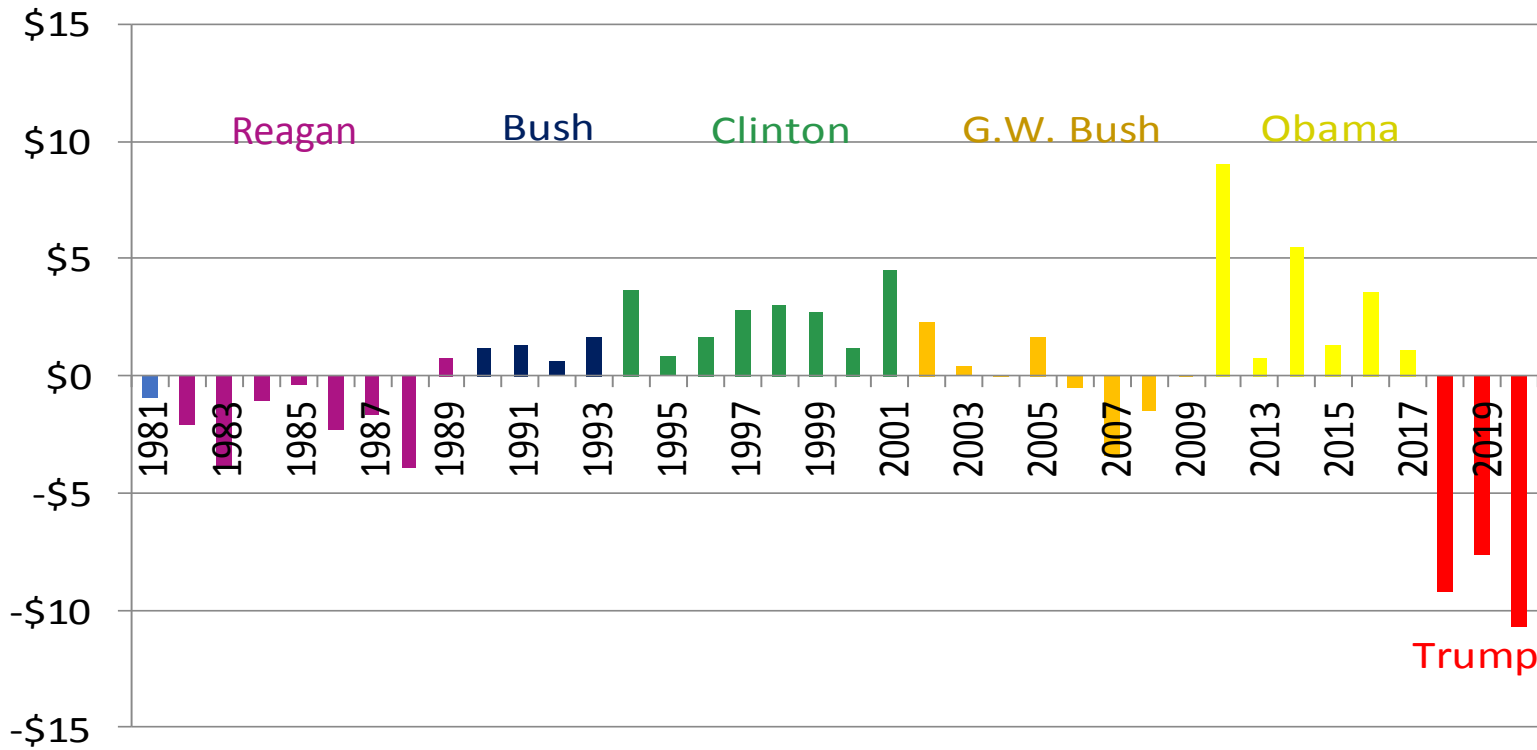
Education Accounts for Less Than 2% of All Federal Spending

2020 President's Budget Outlays by Category



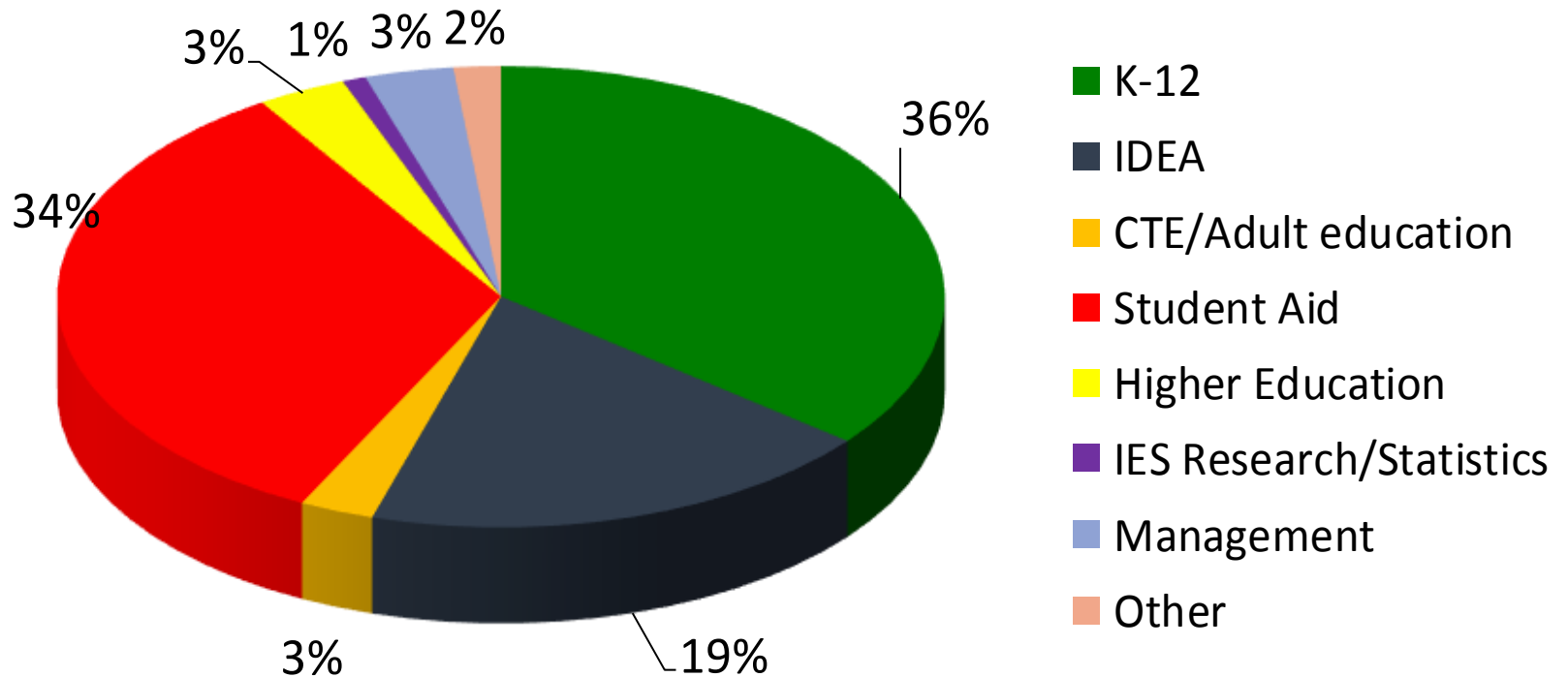
President Trump's Budgets Request Largest Education Cuts

Requested change in Dept. of Education discretionary funding vs. prior year, in billions



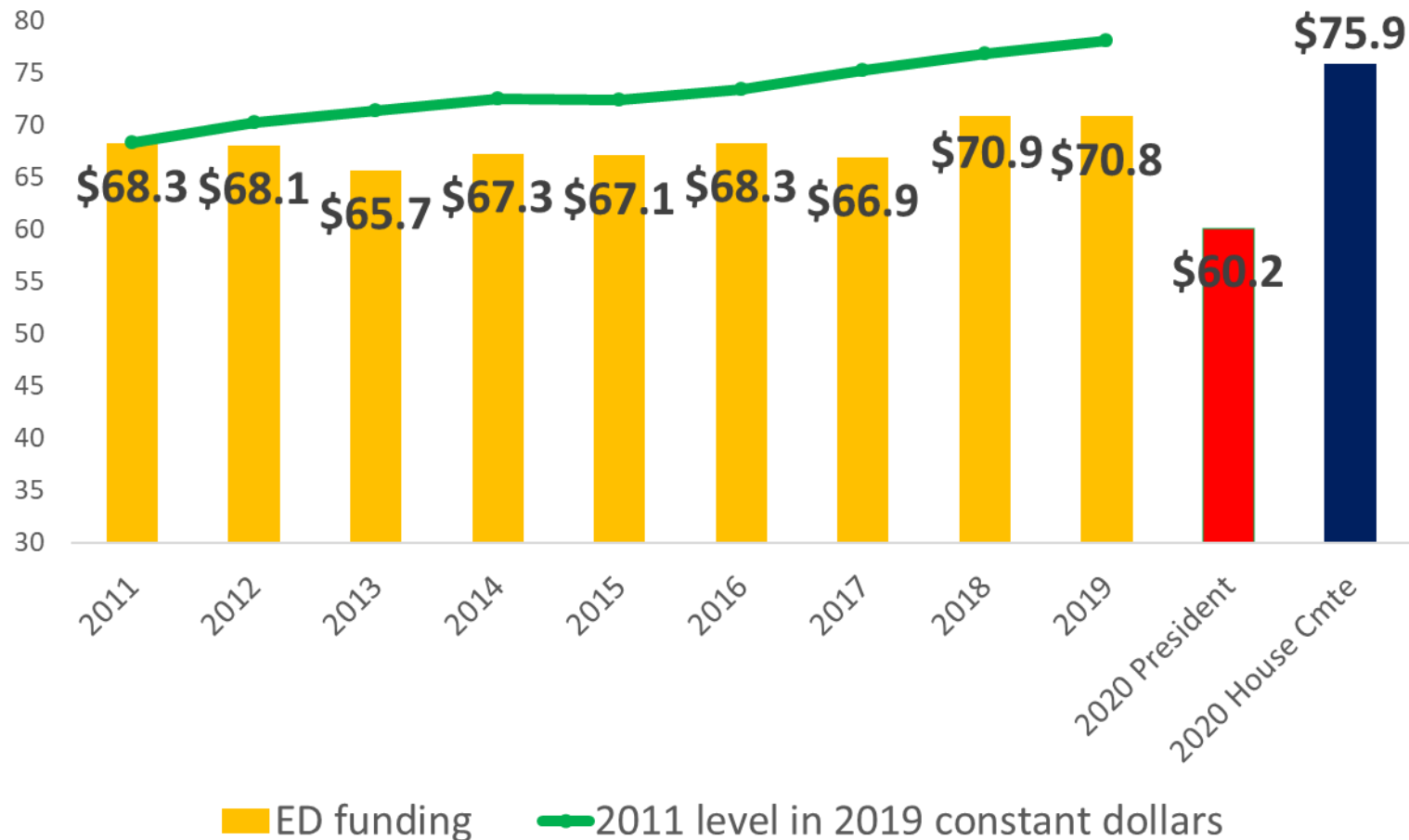

FY 2019 Education Department Discretionary Funding



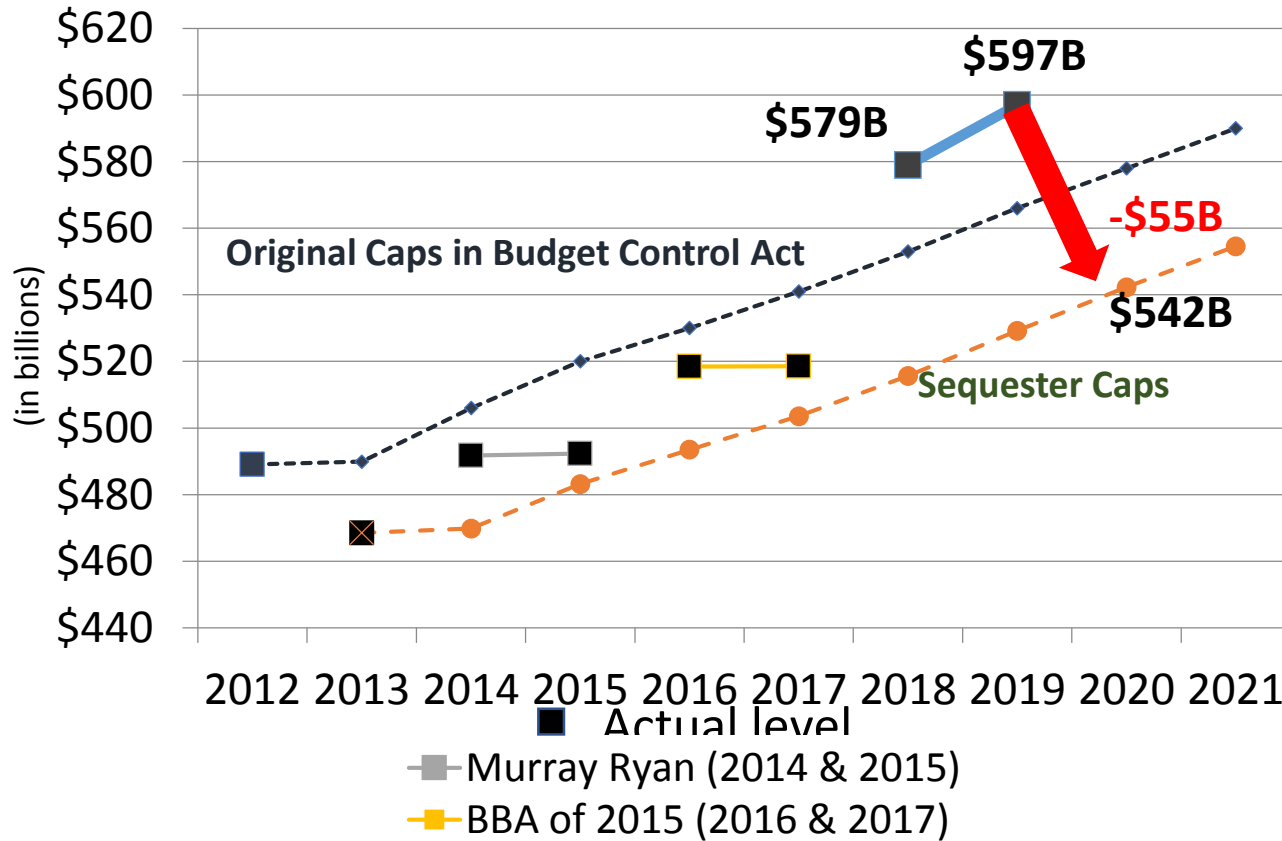
President Cuts Education Investment Even Farther Below 2011 Level in Inflation-Adjusted Terms
